## IC SUMMARY

The IC side, under the leadership of Gerard Wood, began the season with the aim of being a more competitive side this season on previous seasons. During pre-season training heavy emphasis was placed on the basic skills of the game including the general fitness of players.

This approach paid dividends in that the side was in the four for all of the season except for the last home and away game and hence the finals.

The batting was once again dominated by Kelvynne Holmes who scored 449 runs at an average of 34.54 per innings including an 86 against P.W.D and a 60 not out against Caribbean. Peter Rocca with 232 runs at 23.20, Steve Lockwood with 216 runs at 21.60 and Gerard Wood with 214 runs at 19.45 were the other major batting contributors.

The bowling was dominated by Rod Chaney who completed the season with 36 wickets at an average of 11.08 per wicket. John Porteous with 27 wickets at 13.44, Gerard Wood 12 wickets at 12.82 and Ian Patience 11 wickets at 19.82 were the other contributors.

Keeper Peter Kontor finished with 15 IC catches this season with Greg Duffy 9 catches, Gerard Wood and Peter Rocca 8 and 6 catches respectively.
